



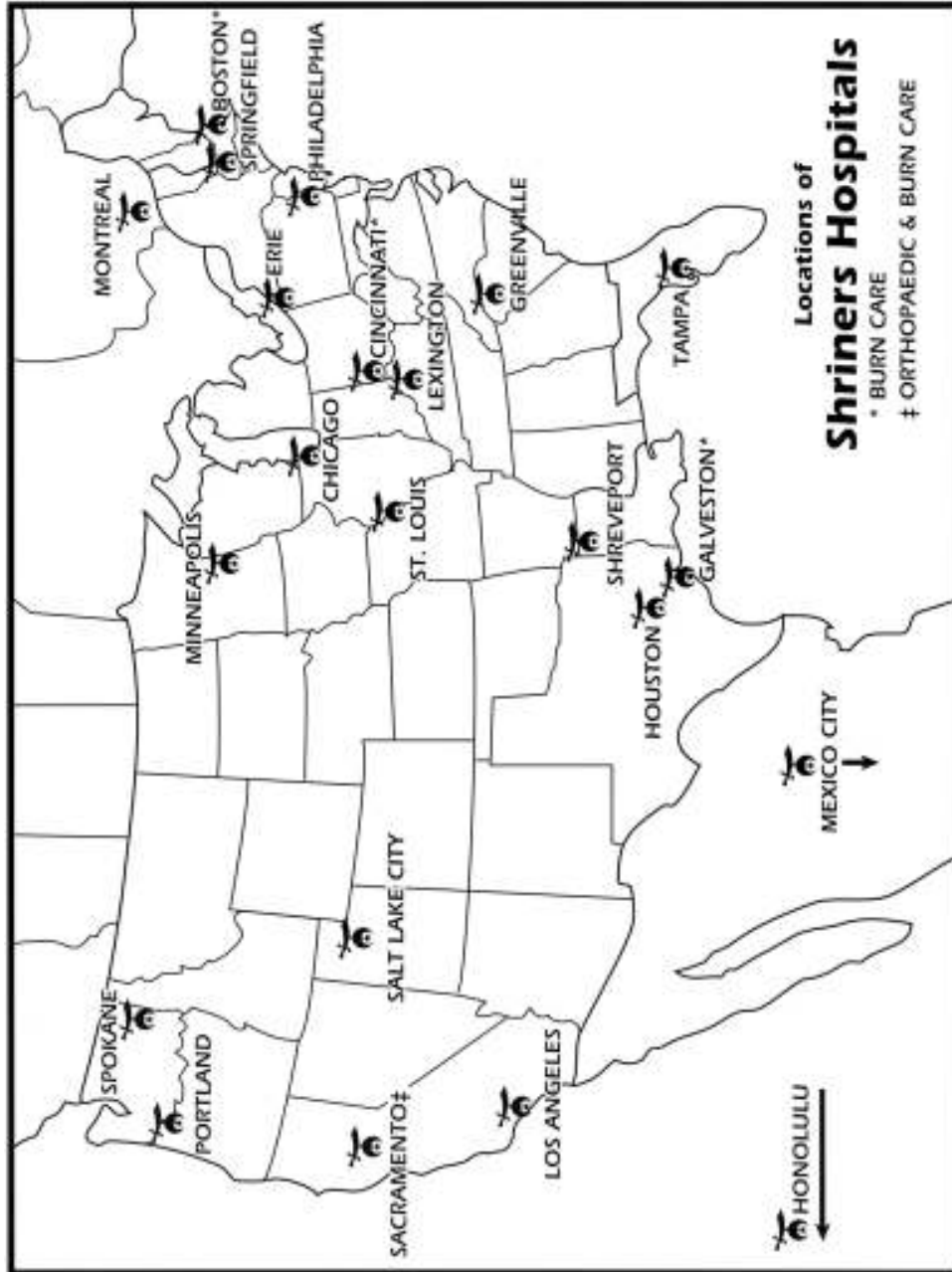

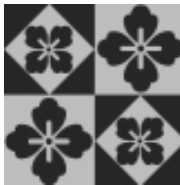

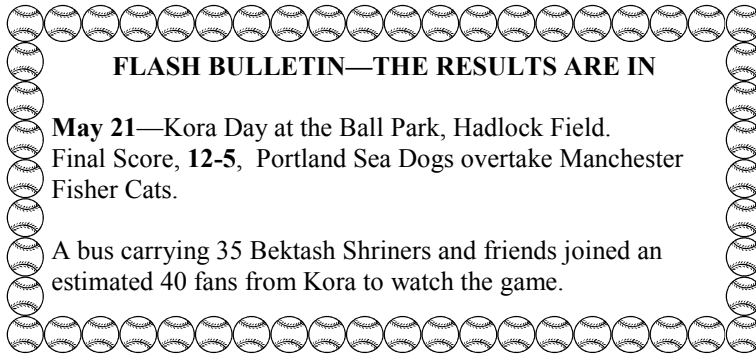

## SPRINGFIELD HOSPITAL REPORT

*Here is a short update on the happenings at the Springfield Hospital*

Fred Parker from Keene has been appointed as an Associate Member of the Board of Governors for the Springfield Hospital. Fred and I attended an Orientation Seminar at the hospital on May 17th and Fred attended his first board meeting on the 18th. The seminar covered all aspects of the hospital from patient referral through all the hospital's services. Fred's address and telephone number are listed on page 5. I welcome Fred to the Board and am sure that he will find the position both enjoyable and rewarding.

Donations to the Springfield Hospital through March 2006 were \$244,287 versus \$225,495 for the same period last year. Hopefully, this trend will continue.

The hospital continues to run below budget by \$245,988 or 4.5%. The actual

expenditures through March were \$5,203,319 versus a budget of \$5,449,307.

The Springfield Hospital conducts their Board meetings on the 3rd Thursday of the month and the meeting is open to all Nobles. The meetings start at 2:00 PM, however, prior to the start of the formal board meeting there is a very informative Patient Presentation by the doctors that is also open to Nobles. If you would like to attend a board meeting, please let me know and I will arrange a tour of the hospital while you are there.

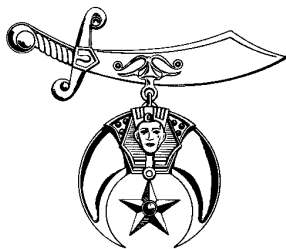
